## Sat. Jan. 28- Sun. Jan. 29 Boarding Manual

Welcome to the 10<sup>th</sup> annual Arctic Bar-B-Q, hosted by West Chester Ship 5. This year the ship has included many traditional activities as well as a few new ones, with more conveniences.

This all-day event is open to all registered (or soon to be) Venturers, Sea Scouts and leaders. It officially kicks off with the mid-winter Bar-B-Q, and ends with an overnight lock-in at a local firehouse banquet hall. We have many activities planned throughout the day. We will be providing transportation from beginning to end.

So, exactly what is going on?

We start the day off at 9:30 AM at the Goshen Fire House fair grounds. This is the part of the day where the event gets its name, the Arctic Bar-B-Q. This is probably the only outdoor bar-b-q in the area at this time of the year. We spend 1 hour in the January weather. Snow or Shine. **Please dress accordingly as it is outside and we only have limited access to the indoor facilities.** Ship 5 will be grilling hot dogs and hamburgers and be providing drinks, plastic ware, condiments, etc. We ask each person to bring one (or unit to bring several) side dish or dessert to share. If you have a Frisbee or game that the weather will permit, you are invited to bring it, as there is plenty of room on the fairgrounds. At this time you will all receive a participants t-shirt, we ask that all participants wear their BBQ shirt to all events. This helps us locate participants quickly and easily in the public venues throughout the day.

The wheels on the bus then roll the arctic expedition over to the DOWNTOWN Bowling Palace for 1.5 hours of bowling. The Palace also has arcade style video games, so if you are interested bring your quarters!

The next lily pad on our frozen lake is Bounce U. This is an indoor arena full of inflatables for bouncing! Moon bounces, inflatable slides and obstacle courses all await you here. There is a waiver for this venue and needs to be signed by a parent before arrival.

We continue to break through the ice with a polar bear swim a local indoor venue that is still being determined. We will have use of locker rooms to change and store clothes. All swim suites must be scout appropriate and only one-piece suites for females will be allowed. We have to follow the BSA guidelines for swimming, so we ask each unit to complete their own swim tests. There are showers for those that want to clean off after swimming.

Those that have joined us in previous years might notice a change in the line up, because this year after swimming we are returning to the Goshen Fire House for dinner. But don't worry the fun isn't over yet!

After dinner we jump back on our buses and head over to Caln Roller Rink for evening skate. Caln is a newly reopened Chester County staple, and skate rentals are included however you are more than welcome to bring your own roller or inline skates.

The final frontier on our arctic adventure is back to the firehouse for some dancing and games! This year we have added a wonderful feature for those who do not wish to dance, a gaming trailer! This trailer can hold multiple players inside its climate controlled comfortable gamer's oasis.

Once everyone has tired of dancing and gaming, we settle down for a movie. This starts quiet time and bedtime. We invite everyone to spend the night with us in the fire hall. Please bring sleeping supplies as everyone will be sleeping on the hall floor. Anyone desiring to drive home that night is allowed to, but we strongly encourage those units that have a distance to travel to stay over as it is a very long and tiring day. Wake up will be around 8AM and a light breakfast will be provided. Pick up/departure is PROMPTLY at 9AM.

**ALL REGISTRATIONS ARE DUE BY JANUARY 1, 2012.** Payment this year will be different than years past. This year we will require a deposit with registration. The deposit will be a minimum of \$25 per person. We ask for full payment at the time of registration, but will accept a deposit in advance and the

balance at time of check-in, if necessary. Registration checks can be made out to Sea Scout Ship 5; however, we can only accept cash at the time of check-in. No checks will be accepted on January 28. No exceptions. Please RSVP as soon as possible because we have to limit the number of people to 75 due to building capacities.

In past years, this has been a fantastic event. This year, we are adding a few bonuses and improving the overall quality of things. Unfortunately due to the fact that our venues require reservations in advance, we will be unable to add additional people the day of the event. We also cannot price the events separately as in the past. The fee is \$70.00/person for the entire event for all youth and adults who wish to participate in the activities. This includes the \$25.00 Bar-B-Q fee. Adults who do not wish to participate in the activities may pay just the \$25.00 Bar-B-Q fee. Please include the sizes of t-shirts for your unit with registration so we can order enough of each size. If you do not indicate a size choice, XL is the default size that will be handed out. Included are all RSVP and release forms. We remind out of council units to secure a tour permit.
